

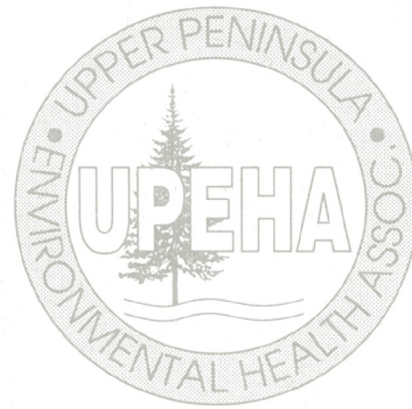
## **HOTEL INFORMATION**
