

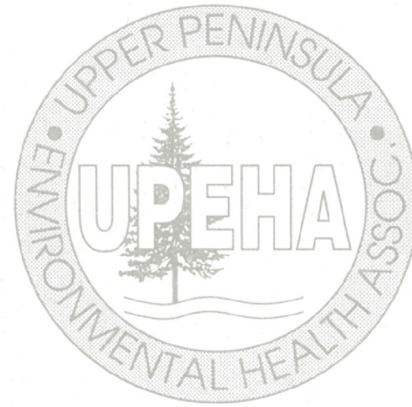
HOTEL INFORMATION
